### 70 Apologies for absence

#### 74 Financial Matters

# 77 Planning Applications

P1391/22/FUL – Gorsley Court – Conversion to provide ancillary accommodation – Council discussed the application and agreed the following comment:

The Council has no objection to this proposal, however, we believe a condition should be placed on it that usage must be linked to the main house at all times.

P1492/22/FUL – Ford Farm – Change of use to tourism & erection of 5 cabins and 2 eco-pods – Council discussed the application and has agreed to no objection or comment.

Council discussed a Herefordshire application in which the proposed access is along a PROW in Gloucestershire, noted that HCC failed to notify the Parish Council of the appeal which has prevented the Council from submitting any comment.
