89 Financial Matters

90 Planning Applications

The Council reviewed planning application:

P1689/23/FUL - Holiday Lets, Ford Farm House, Ford Lane, Kilcot - Change of use of land to tourism with the erection of a holiday let with associated parking, landscaping and works. Erection of storage/bat mitigation building. Demolition of existing agricultural sheds. Following discussion of the application the Council agreed a comment to be submitted. 91 Planning Appeals

The Council noted receipt of planning appeal:

APP/P1615/W/23/3331764 - P0358/23/FUL - Box Bush Barn Oxenhall Lane. Following discussion of the appeal the Council discussed and agreed a comment to be submitted to the planning inspectorate. Due to size the comment will be able to be viewed by requesting a copy from the Clerk.

It was noted that traffic is still increasing to the Barn on Sterrys Lane and it has been evidenced that there are still gas bottles stored on site along with cable reels. Council raised questions about the Barn on Ford Lane that should be in use for stabling horses.
